

Simple tips to help you remove and replace your outdated AGPAL stickers

1. Ethanol wipes

Ethanol wipes should be readily available in your practice and are a great way to remove any sticky residue remaining once the sticker has been peeled off. Once dry, you should be left with a clean surface to place the new sticker on.

2. Pencil eraser

With a bit of elbow grease, a regular pencil eraser is a great way to remove any stubborn sticker glue. The friction from the eraser should help you to lift any sticky remnants off without damaging the surface or your wall or window.

3. Window cleaner

Like alcohol, good ol' window cleaner assists to break down any remaining glue with the help of a sponge or microfibre cloth. For the large patches, it may be worth spraying the area and letting it sit for 5 minutes before scrubbing.
